NPCCU Has Your Back!

During the current economic crisis, it is highly probable that debit/credit card fraud will increase. Your credit union is concerned about your financial security and has taken proactive steps to watch your "back"! Please keep the following NPCCU safety measures in mind:

1. NPCCU's debit/credit card programs have security measures that help identify possible fraudulent transactions on your cards. As part of this service, you may receive a phone call. During this call (automated and/or live), you will be asked to validate charges made on your NPCCU debit or credit card. **AT NO TIME WILL YOU BE ASKED FOR YOUR ACCOUNT OR**

CARD NUMBER. If you are, then hang up!

2. Are you traveling out of the country? If you are, then be aware that NPCCU's debit and credit card programs are set up to block all foreign transactions. To temporarily unblock debit card usage, call your nearest NPCCU branch for assistance. To temporarily unblock credit card usage, call the Credit Union Card Center at 1-800-289-5939 (M - F, 8:00 am - 6:00 pm EST). When you call, we will need your name, card number and dates of travel.

3. Check your account on a regular basis and verify your

account transactions.

NPCCU provides many opportunities to assist you: your monthly statements, branch lobby assistance, branch phone assistance, telephone banking, and internet banking.

Checking your account today might save you from becoming a victim of fraud tomorrow!

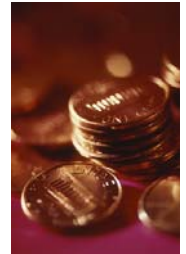
And don't forget, your accounts are insured up to \$250,000 now! Call and ask a credit union representative about structuring your account for more insurance protection.

What You Should Know about Lawnmower Safety

Lawn mower accidents are responsible for thousands of emergency room visits each year.

To help you avoid lawn mowing injuries:

- Start the lawn mower outdoors, not in a garage or other enclosed area where carbon monoxide can collect.
- Wear long pants and non-skid, closed-toe leather footwear.
- Shut off the lawn mower and

make sure the blade has stopped spinning before crossing gravel paths or roads and before trying to make adjustments.

Stay alert and exercise precaution to help keep lawn mowing safe and accident-free!
