Online Credit Cards - all NPCCU credit cards will now be viewable on internet banking! You can check account history, transfer to another account, and make a payment yourself.

New Internet Banking - "It's Me 24/7!" will allow you to personalize your own internet banking page with your style and preferences.


Mobile Banking - take NPCCU with you wherever you carry your iPhone, Smart Phone, or Blackberry! Receive

text alerts with important information regarding your NPCCU account!

Although many of the tools you use today will change, **your account numbers will remain the same. So will your VISA debit card and VISA credit card numbers.** Any direct deposits or automatic withdrawals set up with your current account numbers will continue to clear your account as they do now.

Another constant will be our commitment to excellent member service. The main reason we are improving our system is to be able to focus more on you, our member. With our new system we will be spending less time sorting data and more time helping you with your financial needs.

Have You Opted-In Yet?

You might have heard about the new Regulation E changes that limit the ability of financial institutions to **assess an overdraft fee for paying ATM and one-time debit card transactions that overdraw a member's account**, unless the existing member affirmatively consents by August 15, 2010.

Your checking account currently includes Overdraft Privilege, a service that provides protection on ATM and

one-time debit card transactions. **As of August 15, 2010, this Overdraft Privilege on ATM and one-time debit card transactions will not be honored unless you opt-in to the service.**

All qualified checking account holders received a letter in May, explaining the new Regulation E changes, along with details on how to opt-in or opt-



out by mail, over the phone, or via our website.

If you haven't had a chance to opt-in yet, you still have time! Just log in to the home page of our website (www.northparkccu.org), click on the Overdraft Privilege image, and you are just a few clicks away from maintaining this important overdraft coverage!
