A Warning To Our Members: Fraudulent E-Mails

It has come to our attention that some of our membership is receiving a fraudulent email supposedly from the NCUA (National Credit Union Administration).

This email is requesting that you log on to a website to start a procedure to confirm your NPCCU account details. *THIS EMAIL IS NOT FROM THE NCUA and you should not log on to this site.* The NCUA would never ask you to verify account details over email or by phone.

NPCCU is concerned about your security and will never request this type of information by email either. We have provided a copy of this email to help protect you and your account. You might

notice that there are several errors and misspellings in the email, another indication that it is fraudulent!
